Dear Ms. Waner:

The Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners has received a report regarding your practice as a licensed practical nurse. The report is concerning behavior that you exhibited during your employment at Morehouse General Hospital. During your overnight shift on or about 6/17/2014, several co-workers noted that your behavior was strange. You were fidgety and forgetful and could not recall the door code for re-entry. You could not remember how to reconnect an IV after assisting a patient to the bedside commode. You told several different stories about how you had gotten bleach on your clothing. You were sent for a reasonable suspicion drug screen on 6/18/14. Your drug screen results were received on 6/22/2014 indicating a positive result for morphine. You indicated that you were allergic to morphine and would provide documentation to disprove the results, but failed to do so. You were terminated on 6/28/14 as a result of the positive drug screen.

Louisiana Revised Statutes, 49:961 (C), in pertinent part, provides: "If the agency finds that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates a finding to the effect in its order, summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending proceedings for revocation or other action." LSA-R.S. 49:961(C).

The board has determined that the allegations against you are sufficiently serious to **summarily suspend your LPN license**, in accordance with the above cited authority, and hereby, issues the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that based on the information and/or record(s) obtained by the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners, and a finding "that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action", in accordance with LSA-R.S. 49:961(C), the LPN license of the above named respondent, **Brandi Waner** is hereby summarily suspended, pending proceedings for revocation or other action, in accordance with Louisiana law.

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You must immediately cease and desist the practice of practical nursing and return your current practical nursing license to the board office.


The board will schedule your case for the next available formal hearing and will notify you by mail of the date and time. Moreover, the board will continue its investigation of the allegations against you, about which you will be notified by formal complaint, to determine if you are in violation of the following:

3. **being unfit, or incompetent by reason of negligence, habit or other causes;**
4. **being habitually intemperate or addicted to the use of habit-forming drugs;**
8. **being guilty of unprofessional conduct;**
 - a. **failure to practice practical nursing in accordance with the standards normally expected;**
 - b. **failure to utilize appropriate judgment in administering nursing practice;**
 - c. **failure to exercise technical competence in carrying out nursing care;**
 - g. **improper use of drugs, medical supplies, or patients' records;**
 - j. **intentionally committing any act that adversely affects the physical or psychosocial welfare of the patient;**
 - q. **using or being under the influence of alcohol, while on duty, and/or while making application for employment, or using or being under the influence of drugs which impair judgment while on duty, or using or being under the influence of illegal drugs whether on or off duty;**
 - r. **possess a physical or psychological impairment which interferes with the judgment, skills or abilities required for the practice of practical nursing;**
 - t. **violating any provisions of R.S. 37:961 et seq. (the practical nursing practice act), as amended or aiding or abetting therein.**
