Dear Ms. Boggs:

The Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners has received a report regarding your practice as a licensed practical nurse. The report is concerning an incident that occurred at St. Francisville Country Manor on or about 10/14/14. The board recently received surveillance video footage of the incident. Review of the video footage revealed a CNA shoving the resident and causing him to fall. You were viewed coming out of the nurses' station, looking at the resident and turning around to walk back into the nurses' station. You failed to assist or assess the resident after his fall. Other staff members witnessed you telling the resident that you would not help him up because he should not have had his hand in the cooler.

Louisiana Revised Statutes, 49:961 (C), in pertinent part, provides: "If the agency finds that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates a finding to the effect in its order, summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending proceedings for revocation or other action." LSA-R.S. 49:961(C).

The board has determined that the allegations against you are sufficiently serious to **summarily suspend your LPN license**, in accordance with the above cited authority, and hereby, issues the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that based on the information and/or record(s) obtained by the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners, and a finding "that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action", in accordance with LSA-R.S. 49:961(C), the LPN license of the above named respondent, **Alison Boggs**, is hereby summarily suspended, pending proceedings for revocation or other action, in accordance with Louisiana law.

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You must *immediately* cease and desist the practice of practical nursing and return your current practical nursing license to the board office.

The board will schedule your case for the next available formal hearing and will notify you by mail of the date and time. Moreover, the board will continue its investigation of the allegations against you, about which you will be notified by formal complaint, to determine if you are in violation of the following:

- 3. being unfit, or incompetent by reason of negligence, habit or other causes;**
- 8. being guilty of unprofessional conduct;**
 - a. failure to practice practical nursing in accordance with the standards normally expected;**
 - b. failure to utilize appropriate judgment in administering nursing practice;**
 - c. failure to exercise technical competence in carrying out nursing care;**
 - i. falsifying records;**
 - j. intentionally committing any act that adversely affects the physical or psychosocial welfare of the patient;**
 - m. failing to report, through the proper channels, facts known regarding the incompetent, unethical, or illegal practice of any health care provider;**
 - p. inappropriate, incomplete or improper documentation;**
 - t. violating any provisions of R.S. 37:961 et seq. (the practical nursing practice act), as amended or aiding or abetting therein.**

Furthermore, you should immediately submit to our office a detailed narrative response to the allegation.
