In the matter of: **Shandra Victorian**  
**Applicant for licensure – S.S. # ending in 6675**  
**D.O.B. 9/22/1976**

This cause having come to be heard at a formal hearing conducted at the board office on August 7, 2015, to determine if the applicant is eligible for licensure in the state of Louisiana.

1. The respondent was present for the hearing and gave sworn testimony. The hearing officer did not find the testimony of the respondent credible.
2. The following witness was called to testify on behalf on the respondent:
  - Bridget Jack
3. Exhibits A1-M1 were admitted into evidence at the hearing. The hearing officer fully reviewed and considered all exhibits.
4. The hearing officer fully reviewed and considered the transcript of the hearing as prepared and certified by the court reporter, Dawn H. Hymel, CCR, who was present and recorded the hearing.

The hearing officer, having reviewed all evidence and testimony, and being fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law based on the entire record:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

On May 9, 2014, the respondent completed the practical nursing program at Capital Area Technical College – Baton Rouge Campus. On her First Time Writers Application, she answered “yes” to the question which asks:

“Since your enrollment in the practical nursing program, have you been arrested, charged, convicted of, plead guilty or no contest and/or nolo contendere, or been sentenced for any criminal offense in any state?”

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On August 10, 2013, the respondent had been charged with:

- Fugitive / BRPD
- Exploitation of the infirmed
- Felony Theft
- Forgery
- Felony Identity Theft

The respondent said she did not know about the charges until recently. She claimed the court informed her that the charges were dropped against her and that the person responsible was paying restitution.

The East Baton Rouge Parish District Attorney's Office made a determination that no formal charges would be filed against the respondent.

The hearing officer found the following to be proven:

1. The respondent was employed by Home Instead Senior Care in 2011.
2. The respondent was the caregiver for patient H.E.
3. Several checks were taken from the home of patient H.E. and cashed without permission from the patient.
4. These checks were written out to the spouse of the respondent. He cashed a check for over \$1400.00.
5. The respondent continued to maintain a relationship with her spouse following these events.

The hearing officer found that the respondent was inconsistent with how she referred to the relationship with her spouse.

### **JURISDICTION**

The board has jurisdiction over the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the facts set forth in the entire record and outlined herein above, the respondent is in violation of:

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1. The Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 37, Chapter 11, Nurses, Part II, Practical Nurses, Section 969 A. (4):

- (b) is guilty of a crime;**
- (c) is unfit, or incompetent by reason of negligence habit, or other causes;**
- (f) is guilty of unprofessional conduct;**
- (g) has violated any provisions of this Part;**

**And 978 A (8) Violate any provisions of this Part and B.**

2. The Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 46, Part XLVII, Subpart 1, Sections § 306 T.

- 2. **being guilty of a crime;**
- 3. **being unfit, or incompetent by reason of negligence, habit or other causes;**
- 8. **being guilty of unprofessional conduct;**
  - h. **misappropriating personal items of an individual or the agency;**
  - j. **intentionally committing any act that adversely affects the physical or psychosocial welfare of the patient;**
  - t. **violating any provisions of R.S. 37:961 et seq. (the practical nursing practice act), as amended or aiding or abetting therein.**

**ORDER**

The matter of **Shandra Victorian, last four digits S.S. #6675** on November 6, 2015, came on for final action by the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED**, that the respondent, **Shandra Victorian, last four digits S.S. #6675**, is hereby **DENIED LICENSURE** as a practical nurse in the state of Louisiana and

1. That a hearing assessment fee of \$500.00, **payable by money order/cashier's check only**, is to be submitted to the board within 90 days of the date of this order.
